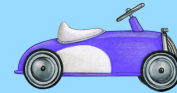


General News

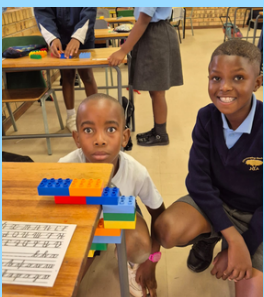
